

**Geography:**

- Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features.
- Use the 8-points of a compass; four-figure grid references.

**Art:**

- Make notes in sketch book comparing techniques used by artists.
- Use sketchbooks to collect visual ideas from different sources.
- Use different painting techniques (pointillism) to create effects.
- Mix and use tints and tone.
- Develop composition e.g. foreground, background, middle ground.
