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- Sponsored read:
 JT- light touch to run, thanks to Stacey for helping. Good collaboration with kids in assembly. Using social media bit hit and miss with the masked readers. Learning – monies raised short of target but is that just perspective? Would it be better to set target in stages? Slice target into more manageable chunks. Other learning: donate to my school page- easy to set up but would be better to run it alongside a paper sponsorship form. Cash was brought into school. ID- yes reduced target but avoid going too low. SL- lovely project involving kids at the beginning of the year. Good to finish with WBD.
