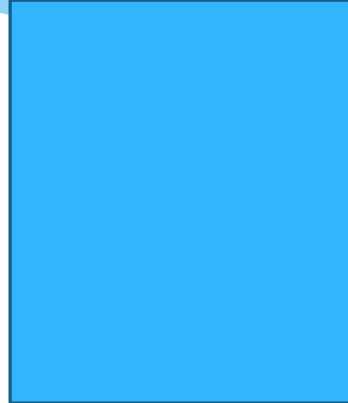

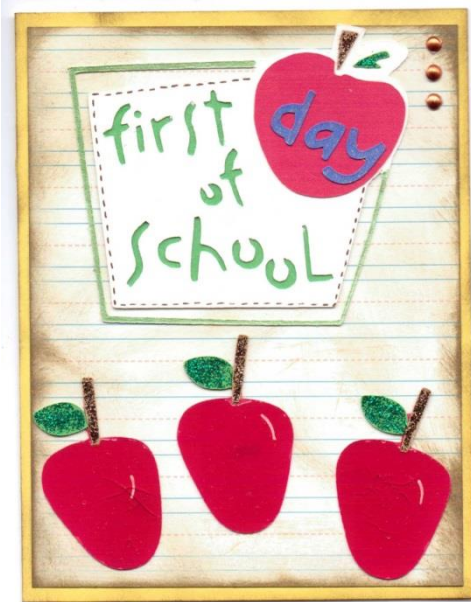

School Days

- * 8.40am – 9.00am – Children can come into school
- * 9:00am – Register is taken

MORNING

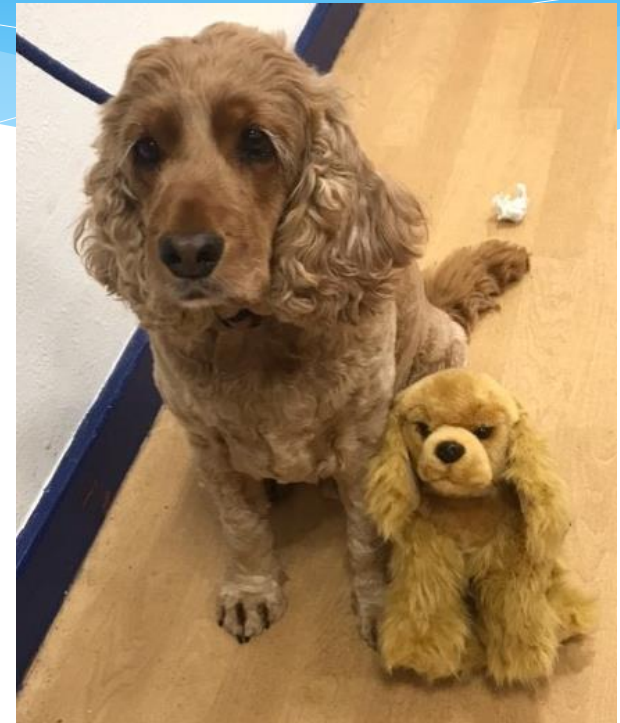
