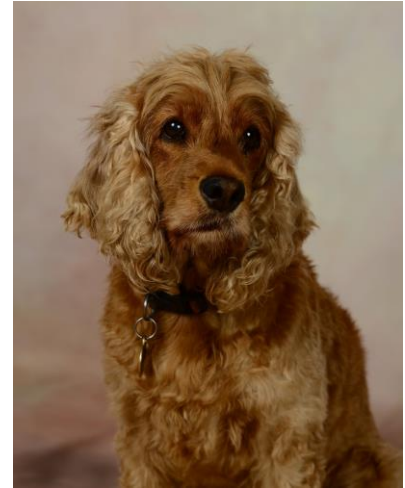


THE BINGO AWARD - THIS WEEK!

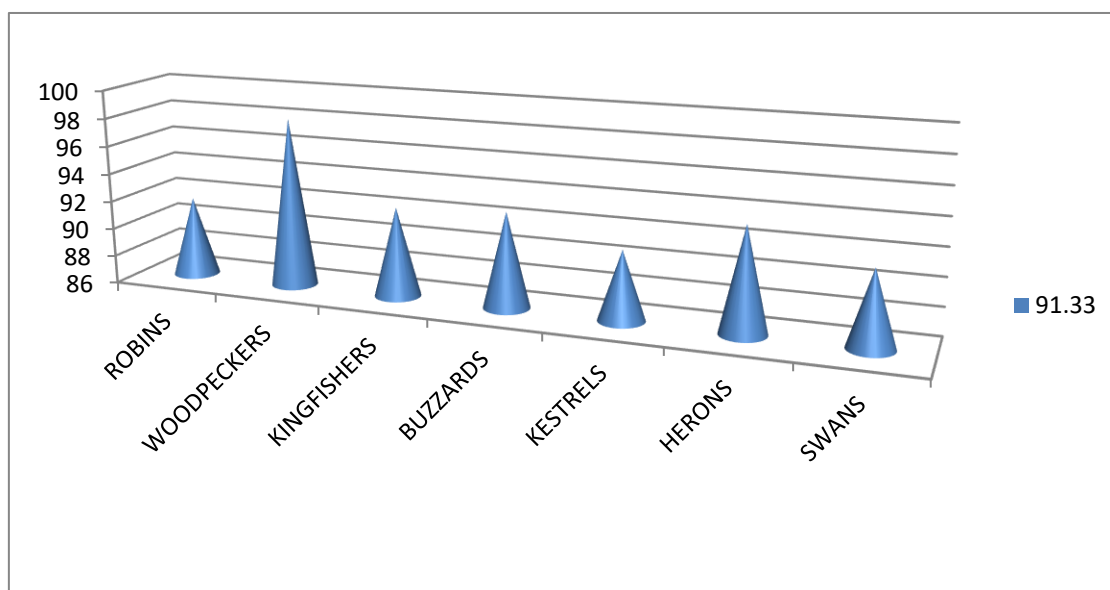
