Dear Parent/Carer,

The pupils currently in Year 6 were due to attend a course of swimming lessons when they were in Year 5 but unfortunately the pandemic made this impossible to arrange. Following the information provided by parents and to ensure that those pupils with little or no swimming ability still have access to lessons before they leave Junior school we have arranged for your child to attend in-school sessions to be held at St Swithun's School in Winchester on a Friday

Swimming will take place on Friday mornings on the following dates 12th, 19th, 26th November and 3rd and 10th December 2021.

The pupils will be departing the school site at 10.40am. Classes will be transported in the St Swithun's School minibus and children will be back at Sun Hill Junior School by 12.20pm.

The children will be placed into ability groups once at the swimming pool (the groups may be subject to change).

Children will need a named one piece swimming costume or trunks, together with a towel in a bag and a swimming hat, if you do not have a swimming hat these can be purchased at St Swithuns for £5.00 each (please bring money in a named envelope and hand to the class teacher). Earrings must be removed or completely covered before leaving school. If you would like your child to wear goggles please ensure they are named with a waterproof marker.
