

School Uniform – All pupils

- Trousers - navy, grey or black
- Shorts - navy, grey or black
- Knee length skirt or pinafore dress – navy or grey
- Polo Shirt - white with or without school logo
- Dress Shirt/blouse- white
- Sweatshirt, Cardigan or V-neck jumper- plain navy with or without school logo
- Blue Fleece - Navy with the school logo
- Shoes (smart sandals permitted in the summer but must have enclosed toes) - black or navy school shoes; suitable and sensible (*not trainers*)
- Summer Dress/Playsuits - blue and white checked

Please provide your child with a school bag, in which he or she can carry a lunchbox, books, homework and various other items between home and school. The bag should be about 30 cm wide, and must be capable of fitting in a locker sized space. Large ‘holdall type’ bags cannot be accommodated.

PE

Children are required to have a white T-shirt, blue shorts, plus trainers and a navy plain jumper or hooded top for outdoor work, with the addition of a plain navy or school tracksuit for winter games, no branded shirts, sports wear or tracksuits (football or rugby kits) and no leggings.

School P.E kit is to be worn to school each day that your child has P.E or is attending an after-school sports club.

Jewellery, Hair, Make-up, Watches and Fitbits

For safety reasons, jewellery other than basic wristwatches or Fitbits are forbidden, this includes phone watches. If necessary, children with pierced ears may wear one plain, flat or ball-shaped metal stud in each lower earlobe, but all watches, Fitbits and earrings must be removed during PE/Games, or if earrings cannot be removed they should be covered to conform to the MAT and Local Government safety guidelines. A copy of the guidelines may be obtained from the School Office.

If your child is required to wear an item of jewellery for religious reasons please contact the Head Teacher directly. We request that all pupils with long hair have their hair tied back during the school day, this limits the chance of getting hair caught or tangled during the school day especially during P.E and playtime but also reduces the risk of nits spreading should a case appear within school.

Make-Up is not allowed in school under any circumstances, this rule does not include face paints during dedicated school events.

Additional School Equipment

- **Pupils should have their own named water bottle to bring to school everyday**
- **Pupils should always have a named coat in school unless the weather is particularly hot**
- **Pupils are expected to wear hats and use their own sun block in sunny weather**

Please ensure that all clothing and equipment is clearly marked with your child's name.
