Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you so much for your understanding and working with us as we prepared today for our key worker/vulnerable bubbles and our on-line learning for children who will not be in school.

In School Provision

The school day for the key worker/vulnerable children who are in school will be exactly the same as their normal school day:

- Drop off will be between 8.40 am – 9.00 am on the bottom playground where a member of the SLT will be there to greet them.
- Pick up for Years 3 and 5 will continue to be 3:15pm and Years 4 and 6 will continue from 3:30pm on the bottom playground. In a change to our usual procedure, if you have children with different finishing times we will ensure that your child with the later time will be able to leave at 3:15pm as well to enable them to leave at the same time as their sibling.

When dropping off and picking up, parents need to use the one-way system around the site, adhering to social distancing and be wearing a mask at all times. All children will need to be picked up from the school site by a parent/carer. Please let the school office know if your child/children is/are being picked up by a different adult. Arrangements made prior to lockdown will no longer be in place, we require new notifications for all key worker and vulnerable children in school at this time. Children will not be able to leave the playground unaccompanied at this time.

Children will need to come into school in their PE kit on Mondays and Wednesdays and be in school uniform on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Children will remain in their year group bubbles being taught by either of their usual year group teachers. They will be teaching a shared combination of the key worker/vulnerable bubble group or managing the year group's online learning.

Before and After school club will be continue to run at the Junior school for Infant and Junior pupils, if you have not utilised this wrap-around care in the past but would like to do so

during the lock-down please contact them at info@theaya.org where they are happy to take pupils during this time without the usual registration fee. Pupils must be pre-booked to attend.

Remote Learning Provision

We will be continuing to use Google Classroom to set all on-line learning during this lockdown. Children should be aware of their log-ins and passwords but if not please contact the school office and they will provide you with your child’s details.

In line with a usual school day, work will be scheduled for each day in the different subjects.








We have provided a timetable for each year group for the children to follow, however we appreciate that this may need to change to suit your home circumstances. We will be providing three live sessions each day:

- The first live session will be to talk to the children about their days learning, feeding back on work from the day before and answering any queries the children have.
- The second live lesson will be linked to particular curriculum area.
- The final live session will be a reflection on the day and story time where the teachers will be reading the class novel to the children.

All work will be posted each day at 9:00am. Children need to upload their assignment work to Google Classroom and teachers will be responding to that work via a short comment on Google Classroom. The morning class feedback session will provide a more detailed class feedback; this and following lessons will revisit and consolidate the learning. There may be incidences where individual or small groups of children will be set bespoke learning and will receive separate feedback accordingly.

Examples of the year group timetables are below. Please note that timings of the highlighted ‘Live’ lessons will remain the same each day. The content of the other sessions may vary and it is flexible as to when children complete this learning.



