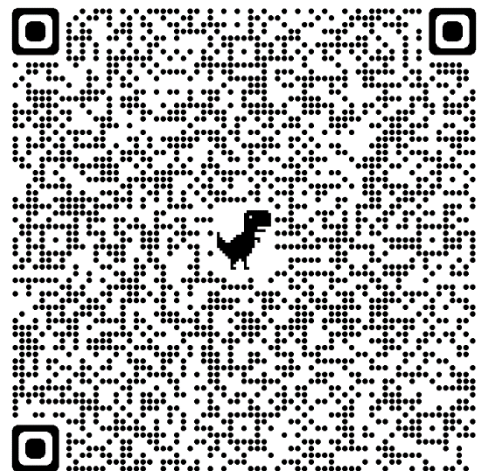
Red Nose Day 2024

fundraise for Comic Relief.



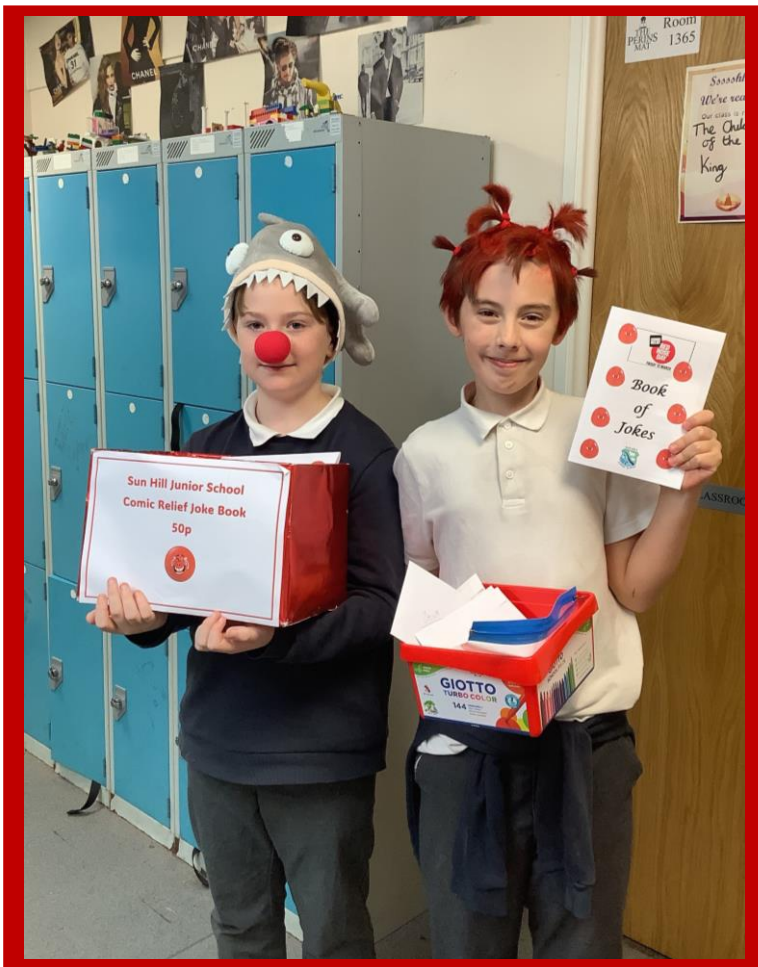

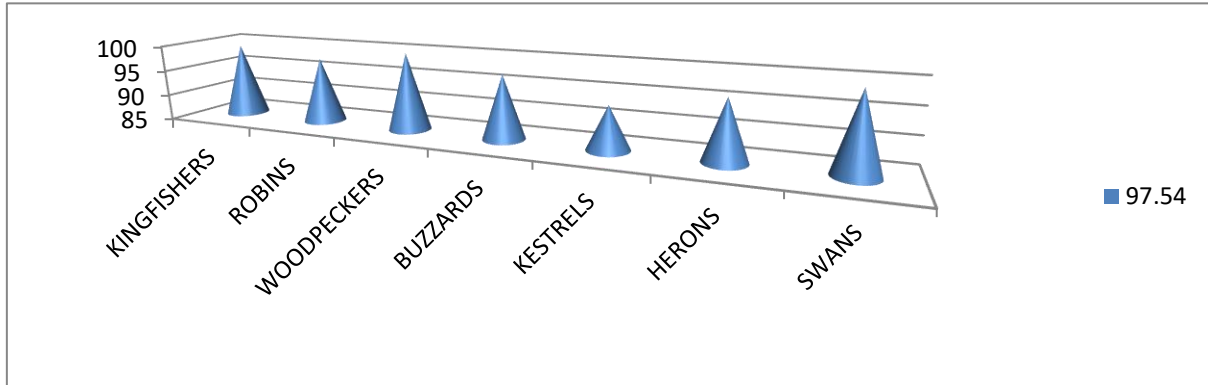
