Tuck is a ball of energy with a knack for causing chaos and the opposite of who Tina expected. She’s sure he’s going to be nothing but TROUBLE!

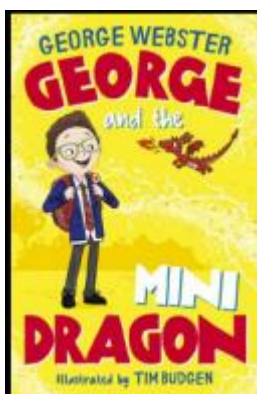

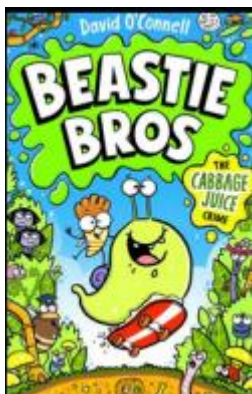


Wanda's mother is a witch, but Wanda wishes she wasn't!

Following yet another of Esmerelda's failed spells, Wanda, her mother and her granny must move to a new town. **AGAIN.**

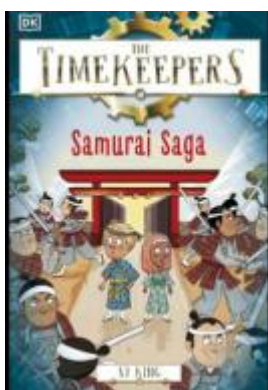

Dash is a little firefly. One of his wings is shorter than the other so he flies more slowly than everyone else, but that doesn't stop him getting where he wants to go.

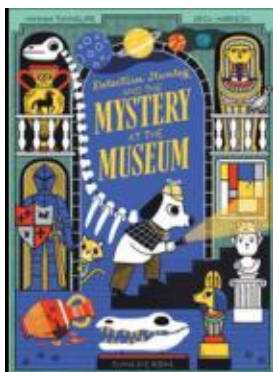

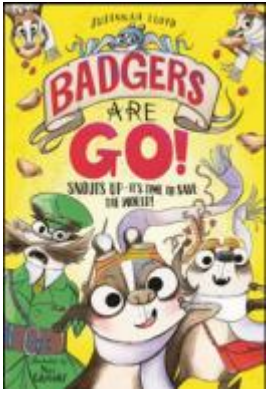
In this instalment, the Timekeepers travel back to Edo Period Japan and become mixed up in a samurai showdown.
